Introduction

Warehouse operations that are orderly and efficient tend to be more successful and safer. It is necessary for the worker to transport and store the supplies throughout the facility in a timely and efficient method. Due to the various activities involved in warehouse operations, staff in warehouse settings may be at greater risk for accidents than those who work in areas with more limited activities. Hence, businesses prioritize warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse hazards is important to preventing accidents. Always be alert to possible dangers and ways to reduce risks. Do whatever is required to prevent accidents.

General Hazards

Common types of danger in a warehouse setting are falls, slips and trips. These accidents are often caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over an item which has not been put away correctly. Placing or removing things from storage can result in a fumble or slip, possibly resulting in both thing and worker to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when staff are moving supplies on different kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. One more common danger is getting hit by falling items. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of incorrect lifting techniques are one more common hazard.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machinery. Accidents can often be caused from the incorrect utilization of conveyors, hand trucks and forklift trucks. Warehouse tools, such as pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, must be utilized cautiously in loading, packing and unpacking.

Dangerous substances, flammable or combustible materials could pose hazards while being stored inside a warehouse. Staff must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards when working around dangerous materials.
