Each of these questions should be answered with "yes" if all the safety rules and regulations are being followed. A "no" to any question indicates a procedural flaw that could result in injury, damage to machine or accident.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating are of the forklift?
- 2) Is access to forklift areas by pedestrians restricted by a barrier?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways well marked and provided?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to staff?
- 7) Are forklift tires suitable for use on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Is an annual forklift inspection and certification carried out?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed job?
- 13) Is there a readable load chart on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various attachments and uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work right?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured right?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the lift truck?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Do operators understand their responsibilities to report any equipment damage and lift truck accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machinery being utilized, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each day?
