Aerial Lift Training Ontario - An aerial work platform is a mechanized access platform. This device provides access to otherwise inaccessible places for equipment or people. Also referred to as an elevating work platform or aerial device, the machine is usually used to be able to access high areas. Maintenance and construction employees normally should make use of aerial work platforms on the job. They are used by firefighters for emergency access.

The aerial work platform is designed to temporary use, providing access to high areas. They are designed to be operated by one individual, with the capability of lifting weights of less than one ton. Some types have higher load limits. There are various types of aerial work platforms; for instance, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

A lot of the aerial work platforms are equipped along with electrical outlets or compressed air connectors for power tools. For specialist jobs, like for instance lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform may come together with special tools.

People who want to operate an aerial lift device must undergo training. Normally, the members of a Health & Safety Committee and their representatives are responsible for the inspection of every equipment and work places and are likewise needed to undergo training. Trainees will become familiar with aerial lifting device operation. They would likewise know the rules that apply to the safe use of these machinery. Regulations differ from province to province, and in worksites which are federally regulated.

Employees who work near or are required to be lifted by an aerial lifting machine should know all the possible dangers. An Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown in a general safety session to educate all of the workers who are lifted by them or work near them.

The majority of Aerial Lift Training Program would comprise modules which are focused on the following areas: hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The particular program is designed to train staff on safely operating self-propelled, elevated work platforms and self-propelled, boom supported, elevated work platforms. A certificate will be provided to employees who complete the program, signed by a qualified individual to be able to confirm the successful completion of a hands-on practical evaluation.
