The tallest kind is the Tower crane, designed for building construction. Mini-cranes are used to access tight spaces. Floating cranes are utilized salvaging operations and oil rig construction on water.

In the crane training course session, daily crane operating procedures would be reviewed. Course content comprises the implementation of proper overhead material handling measures. Right training means less maintenance costs and longer machinery lifespan. The course instructs participants in inspection and operating methods focused on all factors of operation, including right rigging and slinging. Lifting practices would be demonstrated together with recommended ways for review by your safety committee. Sessions would feature demonstration videos.
